Call for proposal: Thematic Routes on Underwater Cultural Heritage - EASME/EMFF/2015/1.2.1.8

Deadline 15 March 2016

The general objective of this action is to promote the creation of touristic thematic routes on underwater cultural heritage and its preservation as a way to promote the competitiveness of the coastal and maritime tourism sector and to promote diversification in tourism offer.

This call aims at realising the following specific objectives:

- Support the extension of the tourism season, hence contributing to improve SMEs' competitiveness and jobs growth;
- Foster synergies between tourism and culture related activities and increase the impact on the local economy and people;
- Foster transnational cooperation among various actors along the tourism value chain with regard to underwater cultural heritage;

COST is the longest-running European framework supporting trans-national cooperation among researchers, engineers and scholars across Europe. COST invites proposals for Actions contributing to the scientific, technological, economic, cultural or societal knowledge advancement and development of Europe. COST Actions are bottom-up science and technology networks, open to researchers and stakeholders with a duration of four years. They are active through a range of networking tools, such as workshops, conferences, training schools, short-term scientific missions (STSMs), and dissemination activities. COST does not fund research itself. You can submit your COST Action proposal at any time throughout the year via the new e-COST online submission tool.
