
## Who is CCIP ?

The CCIP Chamber of Cooperation and Incentive for Partnership is a NGO that specialises in setting up joint ventures with higher education and training institutions. It focuses on the provision of foundation courses for international students and professors. Working with universities and colleges around the world, CCIP facilitates knowledge transfer and capacity-building in programs financed by the European Union in the frame of Education and Culture.



CCIP was founded in 2001 and is recognized by the European Union for the activities devoted to development and expansion of partnership in the world. CCIP is founded on the principles of democracy and the rule of law, to strengthen the protection of fundamental rights in the light of changes in society, social progress and scientific and technological developments by respecting those rights.

The CCIP is established with the regard for the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union proclaimed by the Presidents of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission at the European Council meeting in Nice on 7 December 2000 and is registered on the Public Revenue Department of the Italian Minister of Finance. The CCIP enjoys close cooperation and works with numerous national and international authorities and organizations as European Commission and United Nations.



Several universities have been approached by CCIP for European programmes financed by the DG Education and Culture and the majority have decided to proceed the collaboration in the frame of the programme ALFA, YOUTH IN ACTION and GRUNDTVIG and now in the frame of ERASMUS Plus. The university and colleges remain responsible for educational quality, while CCIP provides the marketing infrastructure, management of international partnership, assistance to the traveller students and professors involved in the mobility programs, finance and specialist
